## Circular for Admission to Classes VI & VII 2023 [ONLY FOR BOYS]

1. Class and Medium: Only a very few boys may be admitted to Classes VI & VII, both Bengali Medium and English Medium. Each candidate may apply either for English Medium or for Bengali Medium. If anyone applies for both English Medium and Bengali Medium, his candidature is liable to be cancelled. It being a residential school, all the boys should stay at the hostels. The school is affiliated to the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education and the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education. Boys are admitted here after admission test and interview.

# 2. Eligibility for Admission to Class VII

Boys now reading in Classes VI or VII (West Bengal Board) or to be promoted to class VII in April, 2023 (other than West Bengal Board) are eligible for admission test for Class VII. Candidates having no formal education in any school are not eligible.

Age: Between 12 and 13 years of age as on 1st January, 2023 (i.e. born between 02.01.2010 and 01.01.2011)

#### Eligibility for Admission to Class VI

Boys now reading in Classes V or VI (West Bengal Board) or to be promoted to class VI in April, 2023 (other than West Bengal Board) are eligible for admission test for Class VI. Candidates having no formal education in any school are not eligible.

Age: Between 11 and 12 years of age as on 1st January, 2023 (i.e. born between 02.01.2011 and 01.01.2012)

### Marks:

- For General Category: Boys should secure 85% marks in Bengali / Hindi, 85% marks in English & 90% marks in Mathematics in their last Annual Examination (i.e. of Classes V or VI).
- For SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B: Boys should secure 80% marks in Bengali / Hindi, 80% marks in English & 85% marks in Mathematics in their last Annual Examination (i.e. of Class V or VI).
- In cases where no marks are awarded and only grading is done, exact percentage of marks and conversion formula adopted are to be mentioned with documentary evidence, if required.
- 3. **Application**: Applications should be submitted **ONLINE ONLY** on the School website at <a href="http://www.rkmvnarendrapur.org">http://www.rkmvnarendrapur.org</a>. **No OFFLINE form will be issued.** 
  - Filling up of online application will commence on 1st April, 2023 from 10.00 a.m.
  - Last date for submission of online application: 10th April, 2023 up to 5-00 p.m.
  - Last date of payment of fees: 10th April, 2023.
  - After successful payment, the ADMIT CARD will be auto-generated and can be downloaded after one hour of successful payment.
  - Please download and print the ADMIT CARD (preferably coloured) and carry it to the admission centre. Without admit card no candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination hall.
  - The cost of the Application Form is to be paid ONLINE only. The amount to be paid for each candidate is Rs. 1000/- for all.

- **6. Admission Test**: Admission Test for the boys of Bengali Medium and English Medium will be held on **Wednesday**, **12**<sup>th</sup> **April**, **2023** between **2.30 p.m.** and **4.00 p.m.**
- Boys seeking admission to English Medium will have to sit for the Written Tests in Bengali or Hindi, English, Mathematics, Ramakrishna Movement, Indian Culture & Current Affairs.
   Here Bengali or Hindi is the First Language in English Medium, and English is the Second Language.
- Boys seeking admission to **Bengali Medium** will have to sit for the Written Tests in <u>Bengali</u>, <u>English</u>, <u>Mathematics</u>, <u>Ramakrishna Movement</u>, <u>Indian Culture & Current Affairs</u>.
- ➤ There will be **four papers** carrying 80 marks in total (Bengali/Hindi: 20; English: 20; Mathematics: 30; Ramakrishna Movement, Indian Culture & Current Affairs: 10). The duration of the Test is 1 hour 30 minutes.
- The **syllabi** meant for Classes upto VII (for Admission to Class VII) and Classes upto VI (for Admission to Class VI) prescribed by different Boards or Councils will be covered mainly. Emphasis is given on the basic concepts or fundamentals of the subjects, simple and correct sentences with right spellings of words and good handwriting etc.
- Result will be published on our Vidyalaya website (<a href="http://www.rkmvnarendrapur.org">http://www.rkmvnarendrapur.org</a>) within 5 days from the date of examination.
- 7. Any information given in the Application Form, if subsequently found wrong, may cause expulsion of the student, even after admission.
- **8.** No admission is made against receipt of donation in cash or kind.
- 9. Boys irrespective of caste, creed or nationality are admitted. Preference is given to boys belonging to the weaker sections of the society. Excellence in co-curricular activities is desirable.
- **10.** In no case, question papers of the previous years are given or published in any form. The Vidyalaya also does not conduct any coaching classes for the Admission Test.
- **11.** Financial assistance is given to a few meritorious boys belonging to financially weak families.

[All dates are tentatively given. Changes may be done as and when required.]

N.B.: Calculators, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth devices or any other communication devices or electronic gadgets are not allowed in the examination hall. Any infringement of this instruction shall entail disciplinary action including cancellation of candidature.
