Report for the period from March 20, 2020 to July 24, 2020

1. Covid-19 Relief

In the wake of the lockdown owing to the global pandemic caused by the Novel Corona virus (Covid-19), millions of people were affected as their normal day to day activities came to a halt. We conducted



extensive relief work in different districts- South 24 Parganas, Bankura, Howrah, Murshidabad, North 24 Parganas, Purba Medinipur and Paschim Medinipur.



In this connection, our Teachers, Non-Teaching Staff members, Ex-students, Guardians, Devotees, other organisations have extended their hands to our Ashrama.



Our Ashrama distributed 66,724 kg rice, 2550 kg flour, 417 kg chira, 213 kg muri, 25,929 kg pulses, 49,526 kg potatoes, 1265 kg soya chunks, 5089 litres cooking oil, 4888 kg salt, 11,447 packets of biscuits, 520 packets of sweetmeats, 1395

kg sugar, 410 bottles of hair oil and 8068 bars of soap among 22,870 families in Bankura, Howrah, Murshidabad, North 24 Parganas, Purba Medinipur, Paschim Medinipur and South 24 Parganas districts from 30 March to 25 June.



2. Amphan Relief

The super cyclone Amphan wreaked

havoc in our campus. So many trees were uprooted; temporary sheds of dining halls and study halls of different Bhavanas were severely damaged. Electricity connection was disrupted and the solar panels on the roof of Matri Bhavana, our kitchen, were also damaged. For the restoration of Ashrama particularly for Vidyalaya we have received donation from the ex-students, guardians & well-wishers.

In spite of all these, we carried out extensive relief work in the areas affected by the cyclone.

Narendrapur Ashrama served 52,760 plates of cooked food and distributed 6300 kg rice, 241 kg muri, 17,840 kg pulses, 32,810 kg potatoes, 3610 kg soya chunks, 14,327 litres cooking oil, 12,033 kg salt, 382 kg turmeric powder, 52,080 packets of biscuits, 1306 kg chire bhaja (snacks), 782 kg milk powder, 3240 kg sugar and 12,582 bars of soap among 16,681 families in North and South 24 Parganas districts and also 7491 tarpaulins to the victims in the two districts from 20 May to 25 June.



3. Online Classes

Earlier, during this time, our students (V to X & XII) were sent recorded video lessons through WhatsApp and now we are conducting online classes through Zoom app. This will continue until the school reopens.

4. Madhyamik Result 2020

The performance of our students in the school final examinations has always been brilliant. Every year more than one hundred boys appear at the Madhyamik Pariksha and achieve hundred percent success. Many times, our students secured top ranks in the state merit list. In the past, it so happened that the top-most rank was secured by our students for four consecutive years. **This year, in the Madhyamik Examination, 112 out of 123 students secured 90% and above marks; while all 123 students got 80% and above marks.**

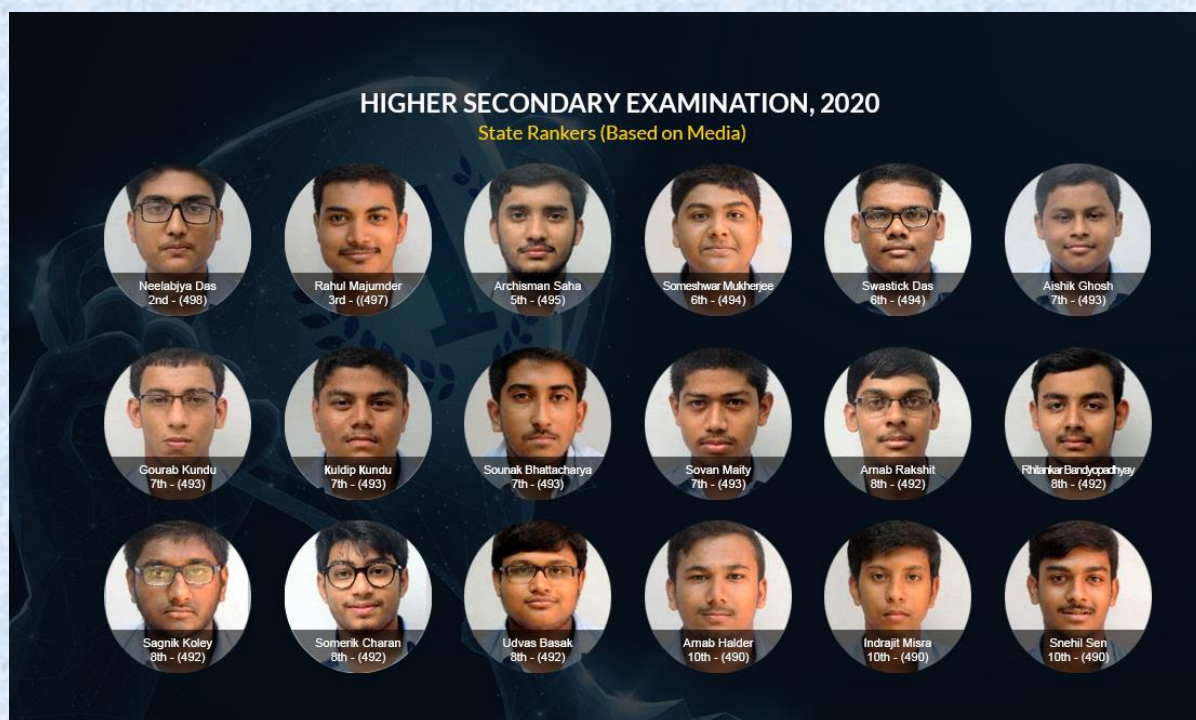
