Report for the period from January 01 to March 16, 2024

1) School Recognition:

- 18 students of our school have been selected for the JBNSTS Junior Talent Search Test – 2023, Scholarship Award and 2 students for the JBNSTS Junior Talent Search Test – 2023, Encouragement Award. All over our Vidyalaya received JBNSTS BEST SCHOOL AWARD on 27th January 2024 at Auditorium Hall of Presidency University.



2) Admission Test:

- a) The Admission Test for class XI (Science Stream) was held on Saturday, 9th March, 2024. Total 743 boys appeared in the exam. 68 boys were selected for the viva test.

3) Board & Council: -

- a) The **Madhyamik Examination-2024** was held from 02.02.2024 to 10.02.2024. This year 129 boys appeared from the Vidyalaya.
- b) The **Higher Secondary Examination-2024** was held from 16.02.2024 to 29.02.2024. This year 112 boys appeared from the Vidyalaya.
